Form:

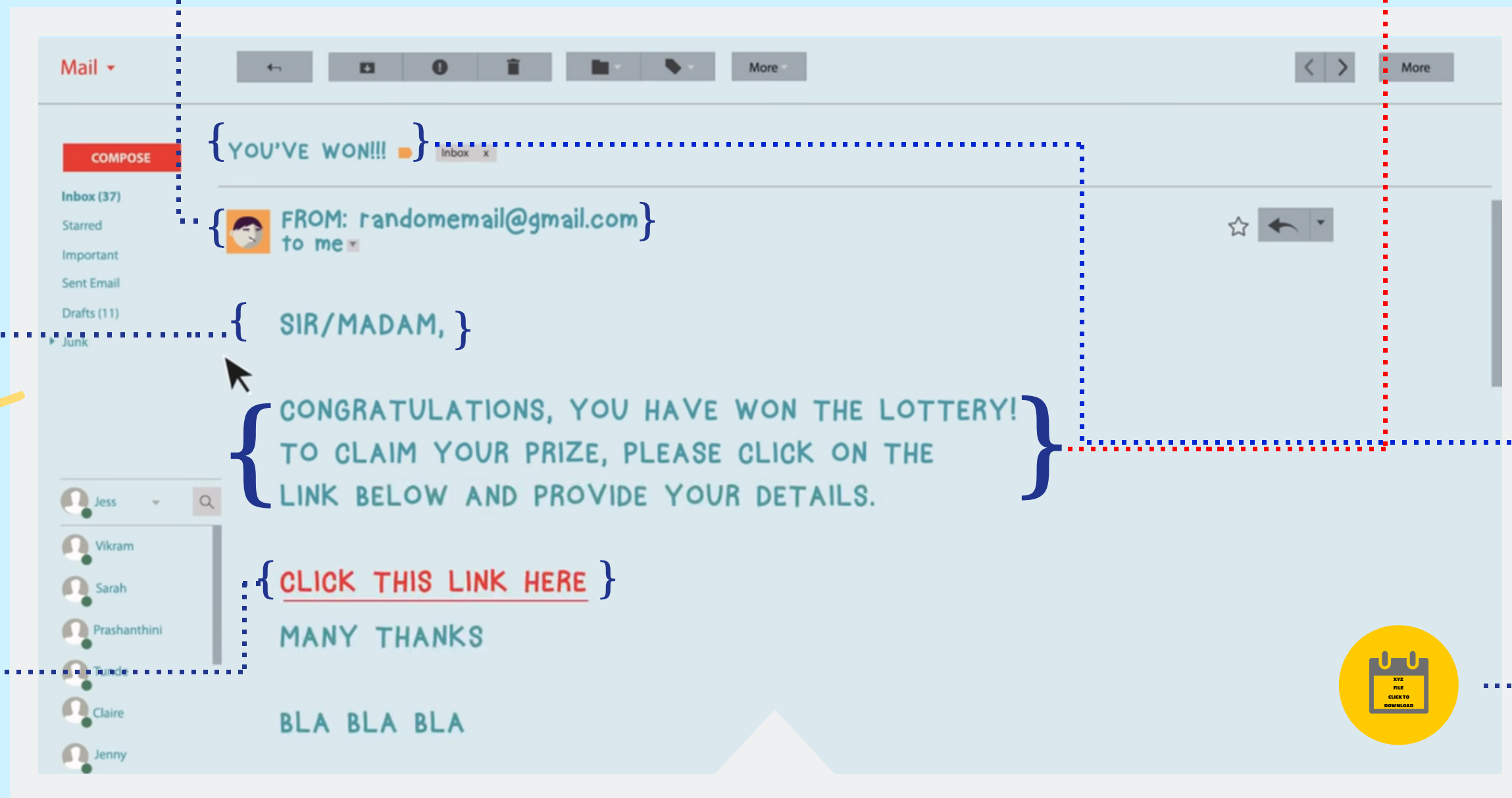
